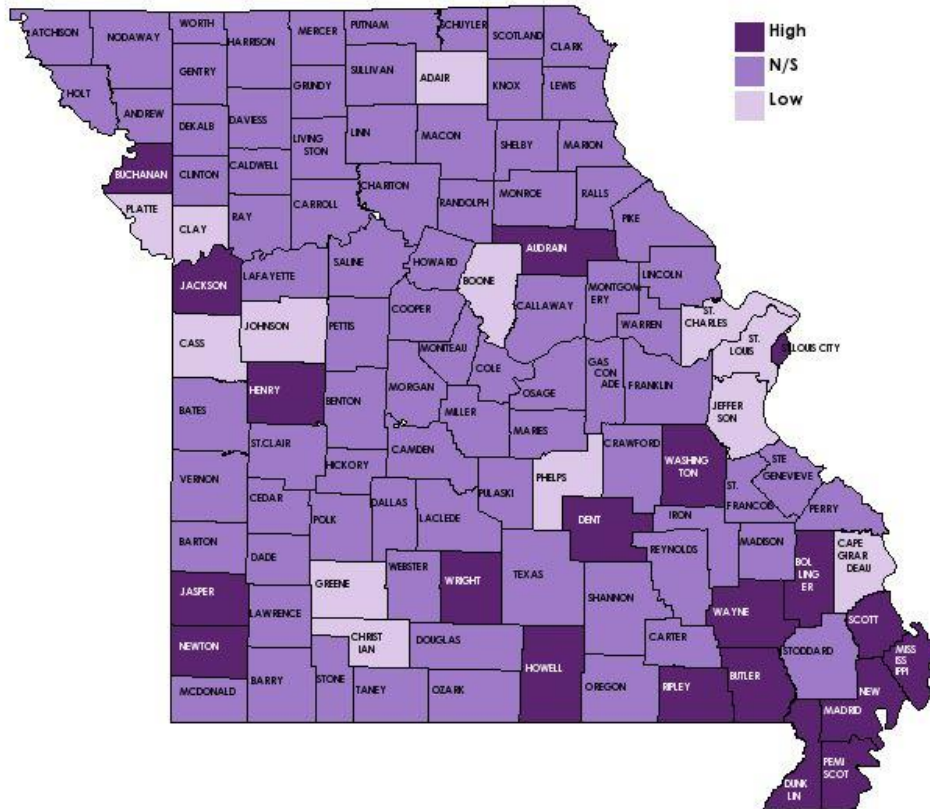


## Teen Pregnancy Rate by Missouri County for 15-19 year olds in 2010

The teen pregnancy rates in counties that are the darkest color purple are higher than the teen pregnancy rate for Missouri as a whole. The lightest color purple indicates that the counties have a lower than average teen pregnancy rate, and the middle color purple indicates counties have about the same teen pregnancy rate as the state average.
